Cirencester's Air Raid Precautions (ARP) Warden's Post System

The following is a list of the ARP Wardens Posts within the Cirencester Urban District and the names of the staff who manned them. The initial list was compiled before the commencement of hostilities with a revision in May 1941. Revisions are noted in the text as *.

For ARP purposes the town was divided into 6 Sections A to F with the main Section wardens post and at least one other post connected to each section post. There were 17 wardens posts in all throughout the town.

The staff of each section consisted of a Section Warden, Deputy Section Warden, a Senior Warden and a number of Wardens.

As most of the wardens were mature citizens at the time, it is doubtful that any are still alive. It is worth noting that there are cases where we husband and wife took on the duties. The following list of names extracted from the total gives some extra information on individuals.

Mr T Ovens owned a large furniture and furnishing store and auction sale room in Dyer Street where the Ice Land development is. There is a mosaic in the footpath in front off one of the buildings they occupied.

Mr G Brooks was the manager of Trinder's Chemist Shop 3 the Market Place. He was a Councillor for many years and the Riverside Walk along Abbey Way is dedicated to him and Councillor Jack Gardner.

Mr Rawlins was a well known local solicitor of Sewell, Rawlins and Logie.

Mr Flexen, Mr Franklin, Mr Hockridge and Mr Miles were all teachers at Cirencester Grammar School.

Major Letts ran Oakley Hall private school and Miss Goodworth also had her own private infants school.

Mr G.P. Jackson was the Librarian of the Bingham Library before joining the RAF.

Mr Clappen owned a men's outfitters at 14 Cricklade St where Ottakars now is and a drapers opposite at 23 Cricklade St

Mr French owned a milliners shop at 4 West Market Place.

Mr Boultons store was the predecessor of Rackam's in the Market Place

Mr Tolley had a grocer's shop at 111 Cricklade St

Mr "Charlie" Barnett had the fish shop on the corner of the West Market Place and the Market Place, now Easts. He was also a famous Gloucestershire and England Cricketer in his day.

Mr Shalles ran a car hire and taxi service from his home at 59 Chesterton Lane which was also Wardens Post No 16. There were still white painted stones in the door surround of the house in the 1980s this was to show up in the blackout and allow people to see where the wardens post was.

Mr L.W. Jones owned Leonard Jones jewellers and china and glass shops at 5 and 7 West Market Place. West Market Place was Wardens Post No 7.

The misses Insoll and Rose ran Lorraines "exclusive gowns and sportswear" shop at 3 West Market Place. This was also wardens Post No 12
